

HSCTE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Amount of Award

HSCTE will award two \$750 scholarship to qualified graduating seniors. The scholarship is to be used for tuition and other direct school expenses at an accredited two- or four-year college or university for the 2023-2024 school year only (Technical Schools will qualify as a two-year program). Decisions of the Scholarship Selection Committee are final.

Student Eligibility

- 1. Graduating High School Senior who has been, or is presently, in a Healthcare program or classes.
- 2. Plan to attend a two- or four-year college or university or technical school as a full-time student, beginning Fall, 2024.
- 3. Recommended by a current HSCTE Member. (HSCTE Member must also be a current WA-ACTE Member).
- 4. GPA: Cumulative 2.5 or higher (this will be on your transcript).

Application Process

- 1. Application Packet <u>received</u> by HSCTE Scholarship Selection Committee by Friday, May 17, 2024 (no late applications will be accepted).
- 2. Applications will be reviewed by the HSCTE Scholarship Selection Committee.

Directions for Completing Scholarship Applications

- 1. Prepare title page entitled "HSCTE Scholarship Title Page"
- 2. Prepare a Personal Statement telling the Selection Committee about yourself in 500-750 words. This personal statement should address (1) your long-term educational and career goals in the healthcare field, (2) how you have made, or are making, a contribution to your community or school, and (3) anything else you think is important for the Selection Committee to understand who you are and how you see your future. Include information about which college/s (technical school/s) you have applied to and why you chose those particular school/s. Let the Committee know your first-choice school and how you plan to finance your education.
- 3. A copy of your **<u>unofficial</u>** transcript (you would need to ask your counselors for this)
- Attach two letters of recommendation, one from a Health Sciences teacher who is a <u>current</u> HSCTE/WA-ACTE member, and one from a school representative or a current or previous employer. Your letters of recommendation should include how long and in what capacity the writer has known you and why you deserve to receive this scholarship.
- 5. Arrange material in order listed above and email PDF copies to hscteboard@gmail.com

Selection Criteria

The Scholarship Selection Committee will use the following to determine HSCTE Scholarship recipients

- 1. Personal Statement/Essay (30%)
- 2. Evidence of Academic Achievement (20%)
- 3. Letters of Recommendation (20%)
- 4. Community Service/Contributions to School and Community (20%)
- 5. Discretionary (10%)
